## HOW DO I ORDER?

You can order by 2 methods:

1. Cash - write your childs name, class and order on an envelope and place the money inside. Post the order in the box outside the canteen by 9.15am.
2. Online - Go to [school24.net.au](http://school24.net.au) and register an account. Use **school registration ID 25198963**. You will need to create a profile for each child you have attending the school. Once you have created your account, you can log in and place recess and lunch orders using your credit card.
